An early 19th century horizontal sundial by Cary London and dated 1807. This 15" diameter bronze sundial is finely engraved and has a 16 point compass rose. It was made for Sir George Mackenzie's shooting lodge at Coul in Scotland and is set for latitude 57'33. It stands on the original sand stone balaster shaped plinth.
